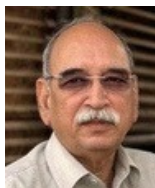

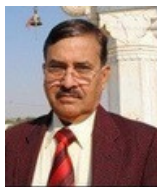

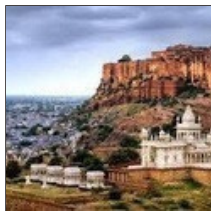

PLACES TO VISIT IN JODHPUR

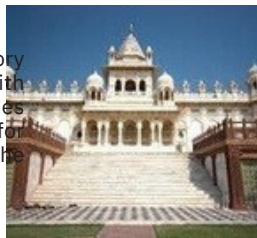


Mehrangarh Fort

One of the largest and most well-preserved forts in India, Mehrangarh Fort stands on a rocky hill about 400 feet above Jodhpur. Built by Rao Jodha in 1459, the fort offers stunning views of the "Blue City." The fort complex houses palaces, courtyards, galleries, and a museum showcasing artifacts, weapons, and paintings.

Jaswant Thada

Jaswant Thada is a royal cenotaph built in memory of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II. Constructed with intricately carved marble, the structure exudes serenity and beauty, making it a popular spot for tourists. Its peaceful garden and lake add to the charm.



Umaid Bhawan Palace

Built between 1928 and 1943, Umaid Bhawan Palace is one of the last great palaces built in India. It serves as a luxurious hotel, museum, and royal residence. The museum exhibits vintage cars, royal artifacts, and historical photos of the Jodhpur royal family.

Clock Tower (Ghanta Ghar) Sardar Market

Clock Tower, also known as Ghanta Ghar, is a prominent landmark in Jodhpur. Adjacent to it is the bustling Sardar Market, where visitors can shop for spices, handicrafts, textiles, and traditional Rajasthani items.

Rao Jodha Desert Rock Park

This ecological park was created to restore the natural ecology of the rocky terrain surrounding Mehrangarh Fort. It is an excellent place for nature lovers and offers trails that showcase the indigenous plant species of the Thar Desert.



Toorji Ka Jhalra

Toorji Ka Jhalra is a stunning stepwell built in the 18th century. It showcases beautiful architecture and is a great spot for photography. The stepwell reflects the traditional water management techniques of ancient Jodhpur.

Fort Chanwa, Luni

Built in the 19th century by Maharaja Dalip Singh, Fort Chanwa is a magnificent red sandstone fort showcasing intricate carvings and traditional Rajasthani architecture. Now a heritage hotel, it offers visitors a glimpse of royal life.

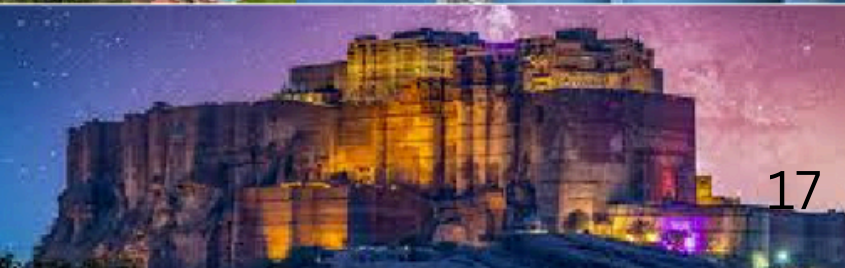
Mandore Gardens

Mandore was the ancient capital of Marwar before Jodhpur was established. The gardens house beautiful cenotaphs of Marwar rulers, ancient temples, and a museum. The Hall of Heroes and the Shrine of 33 Crore Gods are key attractions.



Rai Ka Baag Palace

Constructed by Queen Hadiji in 1663, Rai Ka Baag Palace is an important historical site. The octagonal palace is known for its exquisite architecture and was once a favored residence of Maharaja Jaswant Singh.
